Part 6

Flower chain:

Petals – make 10:

1: chain 6

2: start in the 2nd stitch from your hook: 1 sl st, 1 sc, 1 hdc, 1 dc, make 9 dc in the last stitch, continue along the other side of the chains with 1 dc, 1 hdc, 1 sc, 1 sl st. Finish off and fasten all threads.

There is a photo tutorial of the process on the next page.

I made 5 in yellow and 5 in white. You can mix up the colors as much as you want. (3)

Chain:

With green yarn:

Chain 3, connect the first petal to the chain with 1 sl st to the thin top of the petal, make 3 more chains and connect the next petal in the same manner. Continue like this until the chain of petals is long enough to be wrapped around his neck. Connect the ends together with 1 sl st. Fasten all threads.

If you want the petals closer/farther away from each other you can just make more or less chains before connecting on a petal. Then you might need more or less petals to get around. You can just start with the green chain and make petals as you go, to see how many you need. (3)

If you don't want to connect the chain together at the back, but rather want to be able to just tie it with a knot so that you can take it on and off, you can just make more chains at the start before connecting on a petal and more at the end.
